1. Presidents theme for 2008: **“SAVE BONES-PREVENT OSTEOPOROSIS “**

The following is the plan of action:

1. Printing of the President's theme on all the Letter Heads, Newsletters, Brochures and Souvenirs of conferences of State Chapters.
2. Arranging Guest Lectures/Symposia in State Chapter Conferences on “Osteoporosis”.
3. Arranging a program on Osteoporosis on 19<sup>th</sup> October 2008 on the eve of World Osteoporosis Day. It will be designed to educate the public and to encourage physicians to monitor and advise their patients about the importance of bone health, the status of their bone mineral density and to calculate their fracture risk. Half of women and nearly one-quarter of men will develop osteoporosis, and the numbers will climb with the increasing lifespan of the Indian public. Awareness also needs to be raised about the importance of maintaining bone health among younger people. “Prevention is the key; we need to start with younger people. Teaching children between the ages of 9 and 19 will make all the difference in prevention.”

This will consist of

- a. BMD camps for detection of osteoporosis.
  - b. Distributing pamphlets in local language on osteoporosis awareness.
  - c. Public awareness lectures on osteoporosis.
  - d. Organising Talk Shows, T.V interviews, articles in the local press on Osteoporosis awareness and prevention.
  - e. Distribution of C.D's prepared on the above
2. We are planning to start more academic activities and fellowships for the benefit of our members.
  3. We plan to publish an address directory this year. Please send your address with E mail and phone no. on the proforma sent with the news letter, or update on web yourself.

Do send me your suggestions for other activities for this year.



## **Report of the Hand Sub-Section**

There was considerable confusion in the organization of the Program of the Hand Sub-Section at the IOACON 2007. Up until the last few days before the conference there were discrepancies between the communication we had and the program on the website. The Hand Workshop was conducted on the first day and the Sub-Specialty meeting was held on the last day of the conference! That meant the faculty had to stay for over 8 days in Kolkata. Since most of the faculty did not choose to do so, we had a very limited faculty to conduct the proceedings.

It is suggested that those workshops that are conducted on day one should have the first day for sub-specialty meeting. That is, First In-First Out. This minimizes the stay of the faculty during the IOACON.

The constant changes of the program (up until the last day!) meant that the two lectures on Hand-Surgery in the main conference ended up in a small insignificant hall, one day before the actual announced day. Initially the lectures by Dr. Bhaskaranand Kumar and Dr Warriier were to be in Hall A, but were shifted to hall F or G or some such, one day earlier!

No communication regarding sanctioning of the funds requested was received.

I reiterate, sponsorships are hard to come by in the Hand Sub-Specialty. Profits are being raked in by the IOA. Unless funds are made available, conducting meetings and training programs are not feasible.

A two day Hand Surgery Update has been planned in September 2008. This will be held in either Indore (Dr. Shailesh Gupta -Org. Sec) or in Oras, Sindhudurg (Near Goa) (Dr. R.S. Kulkarni Org. Sec). As was requested in the earlier report, a sum of Rupees Fifty Thousand is requested towards the conduction of this program. And I reiterate, any profits arising from the meeting would all be transferred to the IOA account.

**Central Committee meeting for IOACON 2008 held on 5/4/06 at LHMC,  
New Delhi**

President IOA Dr SC Goel welcomed the members. The meeting was attended by Dr SC Goel President, Dr. R.H. Govardhan Secretary , Dr HKT Raza and Dr M Natarajan Past Presidents, Dr Lalit Maini Joint Secretary, Dr Rajiv Naik Org secretary, Dr Rajendra, Dr Chandrashekhar and Dr Ashok Kalamdani.

Dr Rajeev Naik apprised the house about the problems at the venue-International Exhibition Ground. He proposed the change of Venue of the conference to Palace grounds which was approved by the committee. The venue Palace grounds, a portion of which has been selected was the only suitable area available. He informed that at Palace grounds all halls and the exhibition area will have to be constructed temporarily. It was decided to have 7+1 halls with one large hall of capacity of 2000 and 2 halls with a capacity of 800 each, 2 halls with capacity of 300 each and others with capacity of 150 each besides office space, speakers lounge etc.

He has done quality work for the Cardiology Society Conference and the organizing committee has found the work to be suitable. A CD of the CSI meeting was presented. The Central committee saw the CD of CSI meeting in 2004 and approved the venue and the contractor for the arrangements. Details of the contractor will be sent by the organizing committee to all members of the Central Committee.

The organizing committee was advised to send the accounts details to the President, secretary and treasurer IOA every 2 months from now and every month after September.

## Editor's Report

Indian Journal of Orthopaedics for mid year executive committee meeting 2008.

1. The January 2008 issue of Indian journal of orthopaedics has already been posted. April 2008 issue of Indian Journal of Orthopaedics is available online on [www.ijonline.com](http://www.ijonline.com). By the time you reach home the April issue will be on your table. The April issue is on evidence based orthopaedics. The future issues will be on:

1. Total Hip Replacement
2. Open fracture of Tibia
3. Avascular Necrosis of Hip
4. Intraarticular Fracture
5. Musculoskeletal Sepsis
6. Osteoporosis

I would request one and all to please submit your manuscripts on these titles to be included in the symposium.

### 2. Postage of Journal

We are still working on this problem of postage of our Journal. The addresses are still being corrected as informed by Hon.Members to us time to time. The number of returned journals have significantly come down in the last 15 months. Still there would be many where journals had neither reached, nor had been returned. For January 2008 issue we have received 346 returned journals, the list is enclosed herewith. To improve the postage of Journal, We have decided to post the April issue by courier. After discussing with various courier companies it was found that all courier companies have network to distribute about 70 percent Journal as in the rest of areas courier services are not available, hence 30 percent will be posted as under postal certificate, so that we have a written proof from the post and telegraph department of its delivery. We are sending copies to all those members from whom we have received a letter stating non receipt of the journal. We are printing additional 100 copies to sort out the delivery of the journal to every member. I hope and pray by next two issues this problem should be solved reasonably.

### 3. Finance

In year 2007 we have published 7000 copies. This year we are printing 7800 copies. This 800 increase is for new members (350), subscribers (150), advertisers 30, to send a copy to overseas reviewer (50), lost journal in postage (100) and promotional distribution of the journal to neighbouring countries about (100) and for new subscribers which we shall enroll in coming years (50). The total cost incurred in printing and distribution of these 800 copies would be approximately 6 and half lakhs. As such we have printed 20 percent more than the standard journal size. These 2 issues have 250 pages of academic text and 40 pages extra. By this account our journal size has increased by 30 percent. During last executive meeting it was agreed to increase the contribution of Indian Orthopaedic Association towards Indian Journal of Orthopaedics to 2 lakhs. I would request to please increase it to 4 lakhs. Rest I hope will be generated by advertisements towards the journal.

### 4. Subscribers of the Journal

We have about 250 medical colleges and more than that number of DNB institutions in the country. Unfortunately our subscribers list has only 150 (list enclosed) and looking at that list we found that many of those institution to which our executive committee member and senior member belong do not subscribe to the Indian Journal of Orthopaedics. I would request all of you to ensure that the journal is subscribed in their own institution/hospital/college/private hospital.

### 5. Manuscripts

We get almost 300 manuscripts every year Out of them 60 manuscripts are by efforts of office of the Indian Journal of Orthopaedics and rest of the manuscripts are submitted by various authors. Some how most of the manuscripts submitted are just a summary of thesis and not in the proper manuscript form as given in the instruction to the author on website [www.ijonline.com](http://www.ijonline.com). I make an appeal here to all members

of the executive committee to submit at least one manuscript per year so that we are able to increase the number of issues per year and number of pages per issue.

#### 6. Best paper award

The paper on "Management of juxta articular giant cell tumors around the knee by custom mega prosthetic arthroplasty" is adjudged the best for the "SN Buxi" best published paper award in Indian Journal of Orthopaedics 2007.

#### 7. Promotional Activities of Journal

I wish to send complementary copies of the Journal to neighbouring countries and overseas reviewers to promote the Indian Journal of Orthopaedics. I would request to The President, Hony. Secretary and other office bearers of Indian Orthopaedic Association to start some opening in the neighbouring countries. By this we can get in return some authors (manuscript) from neighbouring countries and other few institutions as subscribers.

### Implant Committee Report 2008

The meeting of the implant subcommittee was held on 8<sup>th</sup> Dec in IOACON 2007 at Kolkata. The symposium title "Orthopaedic Implant Regulations- Its Need and Implications" was held during this meeting. The following guest faculty participated in this symposium.

Mr M Mitra, Asst. Drug Controller of India

Mr CP Puri, Scientist, Bureau of Indian Standards

Mr Ajay Pitre, MD, Sushrut Surgicals Pvt. Ltd.

The drug controller of India emphasized that valid license is necessary for manufacturing, importing and selling of orthopaedic implants. He has given a clear message to the orthopaedic surgeons that validity of the manufacturer of implant is to be made sure before using it.

A very useful decision took place during the interaction in the symposium that a record of these implants must be maintained by the user so that the traceability is maintained. The BIS has a list of Indian Standards which can be obtained from them by the manufacturers.

I must emphasize that a lot more has to be done to spread this knowhow to the orthopaedic surgeons in our country. These regulations must be known to each and every member of the association. In this regard, I would suggest that the observation be circulated widely in the newsletter.

I would also emphasize that we need to have this type of symposium in the forthcoming conference on the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> day, in the major hall so that wider participation and more audience could get attracted and this notification of Govt. of India could also be widely circulated in the newsletter.

I have attended two meetings in the last three months in the BIS for harmonizing Indian Standards with ISO Standards.

I must reiterate that an appeal to start a registry of failed implants must be done which has already been circulated in the IOA News Jan-Mar 2008.

Sub : Status report of IOA House at 69, Tughlakabad Institutional Area.

Before taking up the work, a detailed inspection was carried out, the following items were required to be taken up for making the building worthy. The same are being discussed as below :

1. Seepage :

There was lot of seepage from the terrace, outer face towards 69-A plot and leaking joints of water and SCI pipes. The building particularly the top floor and the basement were in a very bad shape. In the first instance, the leakage was corrected. It was observed that on the terrace, mosaic flooring was done which had developed major cracks. The whole terrace was dismantled and relaid with mud phuska and the tiles after proper water proofing of the terrace. Fresh Gola and coping on the parapet was also relaid. There was heavy seepage in the GI pipes which has now been completely rectified. New false ceiling in the basement covering CI & GI pipes has also been provided. Rich water proof plaster has been done on

the exterior wall towards 69-A plot. Now the building is properly water proofed with all the leakages, seepages under control

## 2. Painting & Polishing :

Due to the seepage as discussed above, all the painting, polishing work was required to be redone. All the walls, ceiling etc. have been finished with oil bound distemper and window sections with deco spray.

## 3. Aluminum work :-

The window air-conditioners were not installed properly. They were covered with wooden ply on the back which was giving a very shabby look. All the plies have been removed and aluminum sections with glass have been provided. The A/C are properly installed now after servicing of the same. Two aluminum doors have been provided on the entry gates of the basements for safety purpose.

## 4. Electrical Works:-

Complete checking of the electrical fittings including wall brackets, switches, plates, defective wiring has been undertaken. New bracket lights have been provided and defective switches and plates have been replaced. All the points are now functional.

## 5. Plumbing work :-

Most of the taps were leaking, wash basins were fixed at uncomfortable height. All the angle valves in the bath room were defective. All these things have been attended to with provision of valves, refixing of wash basins and other works.

## 6. Wood work :-

It was observed that plies of six doors required to be changed, door locks were not functioning, stoppers were missing, door closers were not functioning. All these have been attended and rectified. Aluminum sheets have been provided on the inner side of bathroom doors.

## 7. Lift :

Installation of the lift has also been taken up. This was to be completed by the month of February but due to certain technical problems, this work is still in progress and likely to be completed by 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2008. The agency has also been non-cooperative but all efforts are made to get the work complete.

## 8. Parking

The Parking lot in the rear yard was giving a look of jungle with bushes etc. This has been cleaned and cement concrete pavement has been laid, so that the area can be utilized properly now.

## 9. Venetian Blinds

Defective / damaged blinds have been repaired/replaced and all the blinds have been properly dry - cleaned.

Apart from the above works which have been attended, it is felt that the outer face of the building requires improvement. The madarasi dana provided on the exterior walls is getting deteriorated. It is suggested that the work be got done through specialized agency by the Association. There are a number of broken glass panes which require change. This is possible only from the outside as grills have been fixed in the windows.

## REPORT OF THE ACADEMIC COMMITTEE OF IOA 2008

In continuation with the discussion and projects presented in the last executive committee meeting in Kolkata, the following projects were finalized.

1. Granting accreditation points for conferences
2. Registry of Orthopaedics surgeons working abroad.

Final format of Granting accreditation points for conferences

The conferences were categorized into a) International conference b) National conference and c) Regional Conference. The criteria for an International conference is that it should have at least 25% of delegates from abroad and at least half of the faculty should be international speakers. All the annual meetings of International Societies were included in this group irrespective of the above criteria.

The conference designated as international will be granted full credit points for the scientific sessions. Hands on workshop will also be granted full credit points. Live demonstration and video demonstration will be granted half credit points.

A sub committee consisting of President IOA, Hon. Secretary, President Elect, Editor of Indian Journal of Orthopaedics and the Chairman of Academic committee will consider the applications for credit points. The organizers will have to apply in advance to the Hon. Secretary of IOA with the details of the topics, faculty, delegates and the duration of the scientific sessions to get the credit points awarded.

Applications from international societies should also be scrutinized by the sub committee and presented in the executive committee for final approval.

Registry of Orthopaedic surgeons working abroad.

It was proposed in the last executive committee meeting to formulate a registry of Orthopaedic surgeons of Indian origin working abroad. After discussing with many senior colleagues, it was proposed to send a personal request to all the members of our association to provide the name, address, contact numbers and the area of specialization of their Orthopaedic friends or relatives working abroad.

Hence I request the esteemed members of the executive committee to consider this proposal and permit the chairman of academic committee to send the letter.

New proposals

The Indian Institute of Emergency Medical Services (IIEMS) has informed me that they are planning to conduct BTLs & ATLS courses regularly in different centers of India. They have already started the initial steps for conducting ATLS course. I have received a mail from them requesting the support and association of IOA. Hence I would like to get the opinion of the Hon. Members in this matter.

I also request all of you to send me proposals for new academic activities in the coming years.

I take this opportunity to thank the Hon. President, secretary and the esteemed executive members of IOA for their continued support and suggestions.
