Dear Members,

This is the second newsletter which I am bringing out after I have taken over the office. I thank all the members who have written to me and conveyed in person appreciating the first News letter that was circulated in March 2006. I wish to live upto the expectations of the members and try to do my best to the association.

During this intervening period me and President have made few visits to the Delhi office and have been supervising the work that is going on in the central office.

The executive committee meeting conducted in May 2006 was very fruitful and various aspects of the association activities were discussed.



**President's Theme:** ORTHOPAEDIC TECHNOLOGY REDFINED IN THE NEW MILLENIUM

**New Committees:** Two important committees were formed. One is Osteoporosis committee and the second committee is to go into the details of formulations of the Professional fees for various orthopaedic procedures before the Insurance companies start dictating professional charges unilaterally. The former committee is headed by Dr Lakhota and the later by Dr Jawahar Jethwa from Ahmedabad and Dr Deepak Shah of MP. This committee is important because our association can provide guidelines to the insurance companies about the professional charges for various orthopaedics procedures depending upon the years of experience each member has.

**Constitutional amendment:** Most of the executive committee members felt that we should do away with the status of the full membership. To dissuade the orthopaedic surgeons from becoming the full member it was decided that the full membership subscription be increased to Rs 1000/= which has been accepted. To abolish the full membership we need to have the constitutional amendment.

**IOAICL 2006:** I attended the IOAICL 2006 at Jabalpur which was well attended by our members. There was good interaction between the faculty and the delegates. Chosen topics were well discussed. The organizing chairman and our President –elect Dr Raza has agreed to donate a minimum of Rs 50,000/= to a maximum of One lakh rupees from the excess fund to the association. I thank him for his kind gesture.

**IOACON 2006:** Dr Surya Bhan and his team attended the executive committee meeting and presented the details of the arrangements so far made for the conference. I am sure you all must have received the brochure and might have registered to the conference. I am sure this conference is going to attract lot more members like the IOACON 2005 Mumbai.

**IOACON 2005:** Dr Ram Prabhoo organizing secretary of the IOACON 2005 presented the detailed reports of the conference and pictures taken during the conference. I am thankful to him and the Maharashtra Orthopedic association for donating Thirty seven lakh of rupees from the excess funds of the conference apart from the ten lakh which they gave it at the end of the conference totaling a contribution of Rs 47 lakhs to the association ( which is roughly 10% of the total collections)

**IOA Elections 2006:** The election officer is our President elect. The details of the elections are given in the subsequent pages. Members desirous of contesting must write to Dr Raza directly.

**Committee for Physically challenged:** Dr Maitro has expressed his inability to do the function of the chairman of the committee for physically challenged since he will devote time to organize the IOACON 2007 at Calcutta. President has requested him to continue and has appointed two of our senior members to help him in this aspect..

**Diability evaluation:** There has always been problem in assessing the disability of the physically challenged and the no of orthopedic surgeons available and authorized to issue such certificates are also few. To give the guideline to all our members we will be sending the Disability evaluation manual free of cost to all our members during the next newsletter.

**Preparations for the IOACON 2007:** President, President elect and I happened to be at Kolkatta during the WBOA's Midcon 2006 at Prof.Bhattacharya's Hospital. During this time we visited the Science City at Kolkatta, the venue for the conference in 2007. We found it to be a good venue for the conference with adequate facilities for simultaneous 6 sessions to go on with the Main hall with the capacity of 3500. There is adequate parking space, lung space, space for the stalls and food area. Apart from them, there is separate place for the spouses and children to spend the time when the members attend the scientific sessions.

**Elections 2006:** Much awaited elections will be held for the post of President elect, Vice presidents, Associate editors, members of editorial board and other executive members of the various states. Our Preisent –elect Dr H K T Raza will be conducting the elections. The ballot papers sent by the President elect to the members will be received at the IOA House as was done last year and ballot papers will be counted one day prior to the CME at the IOA house itself. The entire schedule of the elections is given.

**New Fellowships:** I am happy to inform the members that our Overseas Cor-ordinator Dr Dilip K Sengupte has offered a fellowship on spine – Dartsmouth fellowship which will be for a year. Dr Sengupta has been closely liasioning with the association for the past one year and finally it has come through. I thank Dr Raza and Dr Shantharam Shetty for their efforts in getting this new fellowship for our members and I also thank our Overseas Co ordinator Dr Sengupta. Dr.Siwach presented that he had received and most were on arthroscopy and arthroplasty. It was proposed that no certificate should be issued for short term training from IOA.



## Report from Editor Elect - IJO - Prof A.K. Jain

Thank you very much for taking keen interest in Indian Journal of Orthopaedics. Since the election of editor took place one year in advance, we utilized this time to analyse and plan IJO, to have a global presence.

We have chalked out certain areas of **IJO**, which need to be addressed.

(1) Publishing Journal from a professional publishing house (**PH**)

Since good journal requires uniform printing and fixed formatted printing schedule. This requires an extensive editing process, where help from **PH** is of great help. There were three bids. The bids & their presentations were heard by The President, The Secretary, The Treasurer, Myself and Dr. Sanjay Chaturvedi. It was an unanimous decision to appoint M/S Medknow publisher from Mumbai for publishing of **IJO** for next three years. An Agreement was signed yesterday.

(2) **IOA** have grown in numbers and by January 2007, the strength will be 7000, hence we will require at least 7500 copies. This increase in number is about 100% from the time when Prof. S.C. Goel took over. Hence contribution of **IOA** is to be raised accordingly. Presently **IOA** is contributing 8 lacs/ annum towards **IJO**. As there is 33% increase in members of **IOA** since last 4 years, contribution should be raised by 30% (2.66 lacs/annum increase). We are planning for professional publisher to publish the journal hence likely to have more expenditure. I request this **IOA** august body to increase the contribution and help us to bring out a good journal.

(3) The budget of the **IJO** projected for 2007

- Printing cost - (3.15 Lacs per issue)	= 12.60 lacs (7500 copies)
- Postage	= 3 lacs (approx.)
- Office expenditure (includes - Salary of computer operator, stationery, telephone, interest)	= 1 lacs (approx.)

- Miscellaneous	= 60,000 Rs.
- Total expenditure (Projected Budget)	= 18.20 lacs

Plan to meet the deficits

(a) Through advertisement - The letters for prospective advertisement has been sent we, require help and co-operation of each **IOA** member in this regard.

(b) I request the organizing secretaries of next two **IOACON** to please include **IJO** in their plans and support whatever way they can.

I assure to this august body, if we have been able to index this journal, after 2 years there will not be any scarcity of the funds.

(4) Scientific Contents/ Performance

(a) Indexing Process - This matter has been discussed with publisher at length. We plan to come out 4-issue perfectly in time, so we aim to send it for indexing in Jan 2008.

(b) Global visibility of the Journal.

We have planned out online availability of the journal, submission of articles and review process. The website will be ready in next 3-4 weeks time and can be made fully operational during **IOACON** 2006. The details of the website will be given in next newsletter.

(c) Scientific articles should be of uniform high standards, for which we propose certain fixed feature. There will be a section of original articles as well. The work on symposium for 2007 issue are already in progress. One symposium on our problems will be included as a fixed feature. We hope that we should have our 1st symposium in January issue on "Research Methodology".

(d) We plan to sensitize our learned members working in various corners of country on research methodology and stimulate interest in writing their original work. We request The President and The Secretary to take up this issue in centre - state relationship committee meeting for including 45- 1 hr. session on "Research Methodology" in every state chapter conferences. We shall provide speakers on how to plan clinical studies and how to analyse data. There will be uniform contents of their talks.

## **REPORT OF THE IMPLANT COMMITTEE REPORT MAY 2006**

The first meeting of medical Equipment and Hospital Planning Division Council was held in the office of Bureau of Indian Standards ( BIS) on 7th February 2006, to deliberate upon the specifications and standardisations of orthopaedic implants, in view of the notification of Government of India, as indicated in the previous report. The meeting was chaired by Prof. S.S. Yadav. I attended the meeting on behalf of Implant Committee of IOA. In this meeting, a Catalogue of existing specifications was asked for, and it was resolved that detailed specifications and standard parameters for Orthopaedic Implants will be worked out and prepared in future successive meetings. We have also been appealing to our fraternity to participate in starting a registry of Implant failure. The proforma required to fill in the information regarding Failed Retrieved Implants, for the registry, was published in the previous Newsletter. We have not received any input in this regard. We would request to print it again in the news letter for wider circulation and for the benefit of members. This year we wish to start work on this aspect. we request to release a seed money of Rupees 25-30,000 which was assured in the last executive meeting in Mumbai, so that we can start this pilot study on failed retrieved implants. We intend to perform this analysis with in collaboration with I.I.T. Delhi. A symposium was successfully held on "Orthopaedic Device Related Infection" under the aegis of Implant Committee, IOA during IOACON Mumbai. This year, during IOACON 2006, we are going to hold a symposium on "Metal Host Compatibility" in collaboration with Biomaterial Scientists.

## **TRAUMA COMMITTEE REPORT**

### **Introduction**

Trauma committee of IOA is now in existence for last few years with Dr. P.S. John as outgoing chairman and before that Dr. C.S. Sharma was in the office. They have given excellent plan and proposals for trauma preparedness. Dr. C.S. Sharma emphasised the hospital set-ups and their classification, and Dr. John about trauma training to the orthopaedic surgeons. Both were right in their proposals but nothing could have been done because of lacking in the determination by our society. I think that this is the area where our society should think more seriously and take the leadership in managing the trauma in a professional way.

### **Objective**

Trauma Patient is an injured person who requires timely diagnosis and treatment of actual or potential injuries by a multidisciplinary team of health care professionals, supported by the appropriate resources, to diminish or eliminate the risk of death or permanent disability. Injuries occur across a broad spectrum and a trauma system must determine the appropriate level of care for each type of injury.

A trauma system is an organized, coordinated effort in a defined geographic area that delivers the full range of care to all injured patients and is integrated with the local public health system. The true value of a trauma system is derived from the seamless transition between each phase of care, integrating existing resources to achieve improved patient outcomes. Success of a trauma system is largely determined by the degree to which it is supported by public policy.

Trauma Systems are regionalized, making efficient use of health care resources.

Trauma systems are based on the unique requirements of the population served, Such as rural, inner-city, urban. Trauma systems must emphasize the prevention of injuries in the context of community health. Ultimately, nationwide development of trauma systems would allow for seamless and effective care across the India with the ability to expand meeting the medical needs of the community from a man - made or natural disaster.

### **Further Action**

Trauma systems, When fully implemented throughout the India, will enhance community health through an organized system of injury prevention, acute care and rehabilitation that is fully integrated with the public health system in a community. Trauma systems will possess the distinct ability to identify risk factors and related interventions to prevent injuries in a community, and will maximize the integrated delivery of optimal resources for patients who ultimately need acute trauma care.

Trauma systems will address the daily demands of trauma care and form the basis for disaster preparedness. The resources required for each component of trauma system will be clearly identified, deployed and studied to

ensure that all injured patients gain access to the appropriate level in a timely, coordinated and cost-effective manner.

To realize this vision, the Trauma System Agenda for the Future identifies key issues in addressing four fundamental components of the trauma care systems and eight key infrastructure elements that are critical to trauma system success.

- Injury Prevention
- Pre hospital Care
- Acute Care Facilities
- Post- hospital Care

In addition to the fundamental operational components of the trauma systems, the following key infrastructure elements must be in place to support any comprehensive trauma care system:

- Leadership
- Professional Resources
- Education and Advocacy
- Information Management
- Finances
- Research
- Technology
- Disaster Preparedness and Respose - Conventional & Unconventional

I Propose the Following

1) Develop detailed guidelines, which need to be given to Indian government to execute, as without their help it is not possible to have trauma management.

2) Design and develop a trauma training program for our orthopaedic surgeons

3) Design and develop a workable and feasible accident data information system for further planning.

This will require help of past chairman and others in the society who are interested in the Trauma management as well as have direct contact with the government agencies and will require an office to work on these guidelines. We may also plan to send a detail project to be financed by other funding agencies.

### **PROPOSAL FOR COMPREHENSIVE DATABASE ON OSTEOPOROSIS TO IOA**

Arthritis Foundation of India Trust (AFI) (Regd) is a non-profit making NGO working in the field of Bone Health. Our main focus presently is on Osteoporosis, a silent disease, which is responsible for approximately 50 to 60% of total fractures. AFI is member of International Osteoporosis Foundation, a global NGO and partner of WHO in Bone and Joint decade.

World over one in three women and one in eight men is considered to be osteoporotic but in India the prevalence is much more and especially in men, the incidence is supposedly higher. We have no authentic database for osteoporosis prevalence in the country, which can be taken representative statistics of the country about osteoporosis and fractures. We are mainly relying on western data.

AFI is involved deeply in awareness campaign of osteoporosis in the country. We feel lobbying for inclusion of Osteoporosis in National Health Program of Govt. of India is also important. Once included in National Health Program the formal Strategy to fight osteoporosis in both women and men especially elderly will take shape in every Health Centre right from Village Public Health Centers to Referral Centers and Medical College Hospitals.

AFI Would appreciate if an Institution as old and prestigious as Indian Orthopedic Association would enter a creative Partnership with AFI to fulfill this goal. AFI is hopeful and confident that with IOA's support bringing out a comprehensive data base on Osteoporosis will not be difficult. Also we feel that required financial support can also be generated. Let both organizations join hands for this noble cause.
