1. Osteoporosis Committee : Dr. S.M. Lakhota has been nominated to go into details of Osteoporosis & he will be submitting his guidelines during the executive committee meeting of May 2006.
2. A Committee has been formed to give guidelines for professional charges for various orthopaedic procedures depending upon the level of seniority in the profession. It is known that more & more patients are availing insurance cover for their health needs. The insurance companies are making database of the professional charges levied by the Orthopaedic surgeons, for common orthopaedic operations. It is evident that insurance companies may dictate the professional charges for each orthopaedic procedures without considering the seniority, competence in surgery etc., This will affect all categories of Ortho surgeons. Hence earlier to the insurance companies the association wants to give the guidelines of professional charges for various orthopaedic procedure depending on the seniority of the individual. Dr. J. Dr.Johari informed that the itinerary of J&J fellows consisted of 4 metros & 2 centres of excellence in the country by rotation.

It was resolved that a list of prospective Visiting Ashoke SenGupta Professors should be drawn up by appeals to stalwarts of orthopaedics in Newsletter.

11. Report of centre State Relations Committee: Presented by Dr. J.B. Panse. M.P. Chapter was selected for the A.K.Gupta Trophy for Best Chapter .

 - (b) In all future meetings of loa the state chapter Presidents will wear their jewel of office.
 - (c) Lapel pins with IOA Emblem on top along with name of chapter and designation (President/Hon.Secretary) will be made and distributed amongst all state chapter Presidents/Hon.Secretary.
 - (d) A separate webpage is to be prepared for CSRC in the IOA website.
 - (e) In case the membership of statechapter is less than 75% a representative of the state chapter will be invited to attend the E.C meeting. These invited members shall have no voting power.

2. A.K.Gupta Trophy: Chairman of CSRC should make making system more transparent by giving details of marks obtained by contesting state chapters.

Dr.Amulya Kumar Singh's objection that reports of 16th October rally should not be included for marking for the Dr. A.K.Gupta Trophy was accepted by all members unanimously. It was also felt that themarking system should be reviewed.

It was decided that 10 marks for 16th October rally and surgical rehabilitation will be given for next years assessment of Best Chapter Award.

3. Membership Drive: All members are requested to help in the membership drive. The growth of membership is about 1.7% per year.

4. All state chapter President/Hon.Secretary will mail the announcement of the forthcoming state chapters meetings to all President/Hon.Secretary of other state chapters inviting them to attend their meetings. They should provide decent accomodation + free registration to those who attend..

5. All state chapters will continue the "NITA" and Polio Campaigns in their states in 2006 as well.

6. Dr. S.C. Goel, editor IJO will be requested to send the members' CD preferably arranged statewise, to enable state chapter office bearers to find out names of their own members who are not IOA members, and to motivate the letter to join IOA.

7. The President-elect will write to all office bearers of the state chapters in the January to request them to send the proposed dates of any meeting in the year of his presidency. The dates of the meeting should only be finalised after clearance from him failing which the IOA President/President-elect, Hon.Secretary may not attend their meeting.

8. The Professional Indemnity Scheme of IOA should be strengthened by placed a target of 50 for each state chapter for year 2006. A technical committee should be formulated as follows: "Technical committee for IOA Professional Indemnity Scheme.

The application forms and full information of the scheme can be tagged to each application form for new membership. The scheme should be promoted amongst the members who have freshly joined the association.

Dr. A.N.Varma/Dr.Deepak Shah may be invited to attend and deliver talks on consumer protection in various state chapter meetings. At least one way ll A.C fare should be paid by IOA to Dr. A.N.Varma/Dr.Deepak Shah to attend these meetings.

With no other matter to be discussed, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.

IMPLANT COMMITTEE REPORT

I take this opportunity to submit the Implant Sub Committee Report for the year 2005 and would like to inform you that the Ministry of health and Family Welfare has brought out a Notification on 6th Oct. 2005 which specifies the orthopaedic implants as sterile devices intended for use in human beings as products. A copy of the notification is enclosed for your perusal.

This notification is very important from the point of view of developing certification mark on the products standards by the manufacturers.

The agenda for the Implant Sub Committee for the forthcoming year would be:

1. To examine the list of Indian standards and modify or delete the obsolete ones.
2. Available standards would be harmonized with ISO standards so that Indian standards of orthopaedic implants are of good quality. We will have to approach the drug controller of India in this matter. We have send an appeal in last meeting regarding the analysis of retrieve implants and have suggested registry of implant failure to be set up and detailed Performa in this regard was developed which was circulated to all members of the association through News Letter Jan-March 2005. We have not yet got any response from the members . I would request that this appeal may again be circulated in the News Letter. We would require finances in this regard. Initially this could be funded with Rs.25-30 thousands where a pilot study can be done and those members who are interested to get analysis of their implant failures may contribute the amount to the Implant sub Committee accordingly.

In the present scenario it is important in the legal point of view that those implant should be used which bear the insignia of the respective manufacturer. The Implant Sub Committee would delebrate on all this issues in the conference. We have organized a symposium on Implant associated infections in orthopaedic surgery followed by free paper session and best presentation would be given Sushrut award IOACON 2005.

Thank you very much for all help and faith on me to take care of the Implant sub Committee.

9380 operations were carried out by above mentioned surgeons in the table during the Golden Jubilee Year. There are many more who have done fairly big number of surgeries but have not communicated. Those who have performed three to five operations have not communicated to us and hence we can not have the exact number of procedures carried out.

I am happy that IOA and the members of IOA have made a difference in the lives of more than 15000 disabled and their family members in our Golden Jubilee year with the help of our other specialist friends like anesthetists, pathologists, physiotherapists and radiologists and many charitable hospitals and social service organizations.

Dr. M. M. Bapan, our senior member from Bharatpur Rajasthan gives the details of financial issue about the work carried out in his institute. Cost to the organization (Bhagwan Mahavir Viklang Sahayta Samiti) for 229 operation was Rs. 5,68,836/- Per patient the cost comes to Rs. 2484/-.

The surgeon's services were free.

15000 operations would have cost at least Rs. 37260000-

Surgeon's fee could be at least Rs. 3000/- for an operation on an average and could have cost Rs. 45000000/-

Half of the operated patients must have required orthotic device. Each would have cost Rs. 500/- at least. The cost could have come to Rs. 3750000/-

At least 15000 operations were carried out completely free and the patient population has saved Rs. 86010000/-

IOA project 'Residual Polio Paralysis Disabled – Free India' has become one of the best examples of selfless contribution to the society by any association of professionals in our country.

OSTEOPOROSIS SUBCOMMITTEE OF IOA

• Thanks for the overwhelming support in the Annual General Meeting at Mumbai 2005 of our association for the formation of this-committee. I am also honoured to chair the committee.

My ideas are narrated below. I need your valuable suggestions to give these ideas a proper shape and implementation.

Committee Formation:

- To make a Central committee comprising of our members from all over India, who are already working in this field or are interested in this subject. There would be two representatives from each zone (North, South, East, West and Central zones).
- All state chapters should have an Osteoporosis sub committee.

Aims and Objectives:

- Standardisation of BMD reports:
- Dexa scan reports are the gold standard for the diagnosis of Osteoporosis. Peak Bone Mass data is essential for the assessment of Standard Deviation in the elderly population to give T score & Z score readings. Unfortunately we do not have this data of our population. Presently the reports are based on data from Caucasians population.
- To achieve this goal a minimum number of 1000 volunteers from each zone should be subjected to dexa scan and the reports should be compiled to give a figure of our National Peak Bone Mass value. This value should be fed in the software of dexa scanners to make the reports rational and relevant.
- This needs funds. I have already talked with the pharmaceutical companies who have products to treat Osteoporosis. I have spoken with the local Dexa Scanning centres. They are willing to help. We will have to negotiated with them to come forward and help this national cause. Free Dexa scan can be done at Medical Colleges where this facility is available. A nominal charge of 100 to 200 Rs. can be negotiated with the Dexa Scanning centres. The volunteers can be arranged from the medical or other colleges.
- I have talked with Novartis, Aventis, Dr Reddy's, Sun Pharma and Cipla. The talks are in the initial Stage and I would request you to kindly speak with them on the behalf of the association. One Pharma company can take the responsibility of one zone.
- Preferably the dexa scan should be done at one centre so that the chances of variation from machine to machine can be controlled. A parallel study should be done with ultrasonographic technique in the measurement from Calcaneum of peak Bone Mass. The two studies should be compared for any deviations and accuracy. This study can be without any extra cost with the help of many Pharmaceutical companies who have their portable US machine

Setting up of Protocols for:

- Indications for Dexa Scan and how often.
- Parts of the body to be scanned.
- Understanding of the Dexa reports and its clinical relevance.
- Medical treatment
- When to start?
- What to start?
- How long to continue?
- Advise on diet.
- Role of weight bearing/aerobic exercises.
- Role of Sunlight.
- What are the expectations by the patient?
- What are expectations by the treating doctor?
- Role of HRT/ SERM/ Calcium/ Bisphosphonates/ Calcitonin/ PTH/ Vit D and its analogues should be clearly defined.
- In post fracture medical treatment, the treatment for Osteoporosis to be initiated for the "People at risk" group.

Public Awareness:

- Meeting with public for awareness of Osteoporosis in the Rotary, Lions, Social Clubs or other platforms to be done by our members at all levels. Writing of articles in the local news paper, Magazine or television talks should be encouraged.

CME for the Orthopaedic Surgeons, Primary health care physician and other health care personals:

- All annual meetings of the state chapters and IOACON should have a dedicated session on the subject.
- Interactive seminars and meetings may be organised with IMA and other professional bodies.

Negotiation with the medical and health insurance provider to include reimbursement for the medical Treatment of Osteoporosis

In this regards I need your suggestions. I would appreciate your endeavours to provide me:

- The names of interested persons in your area.
- Negotiation with the Pharmaceutical companies to take active part in this task.
- Negotiation with the Dexa Scan Centres to help achieving the goal.
- To put Osteoporosis as a national Agenda in the health care planning of INDIA.

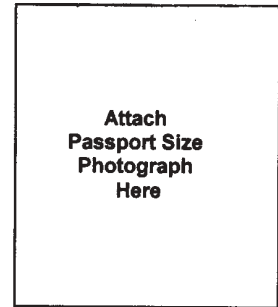
