## **REPORT OF THE DR. ASHOKE SENGUPTA VISITING PROFESSORSHIP**

I was privileged to be invited to BHU, Varanasi by Prof. S.C. Goel as the Visiting Professor this year. I reached Varanasi on the 25<sup>th</sup> July.

The first day was spent in post graduate teaching and case discussions. Nearly 30 paediatric cases were put up for discussion. They covered a very wide spectrum and virtually the whole gamut of day to day paediatric practice. Congenital problems, infections and post trauma sequelae all provided for very interesting discussions and from these cases, selection were made for the next days operation theatre list.

The second day morning was spent in the OR and I demonstrated a femoral osteotomy with a trochanteric epiphysiodesis for a case of Perthes disease with a hinge abduction. The second demonstration was for a neglected congenital club foot in a 5 year old patient. This patient underwent a posteromedial release along with a Lichtblau procedure. The reduction was held with K wires.

In the afternoon I gave lectures to the department and visiting surgeons of Varanasi. The Varanasi Orthopaedic Club held its meeting the same evening. It was a good and fairly big group of surgeons to whom I lectured and this was followed by dinner organised by the club.

The next morning was occupied fully by lectures and I lectured on various topics like DDH, CTEV, Cerebral Palsy, Spinal deformities etc. The department joined in for a farewell lunch on this, Sunday afternoon.

My personal feelings were that the visiting professorship was a good avenue for exchange of views and for teaching in a non formal way. The post graduates were enthused and got the benefit of update and exposure to various areas in paediatric orthopaedics. For the department too, it was an event, enthusiastically organised and in which all staff members participated with gusto.

In closing, I would like to thank the orthopaedic department of BHU under the leadership of Prof. S.C. Goel for this opportunity and for the fond welcome they gave me. Dr. Saraf, Dr. Khare, Dr. Rai, Dr. Amit Rastogi all made me feel at home and shared orthopaedic experiences. If I were to sum up my experience in one word, it was 'superb'.

## MINUTES OF THE CENTRAL PROGRAM COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 10<sup>TH</sup> & 11<sup>TH</sup> OF AUGUST 2008 AT BENGALURU

Following members attended the meeting-

Dr SC Goel, Dr Shantharam Shetty, Dr HKT Raza ,Dr Mayil V Natarajan,Dr R H Govardhan,Dr Sudhir Kapoor, Dr Rajendra, Dr Rajeev Naik, Dr Narendra, Dr BB Putti, Dr Mallaya,Dr Chandrasekar,Dr Govindaraju, Dr Naresh Shetty, Dr Ram Subba Reddy, Dr Ram Iyer

Dr Rajendra welcomed the gathering.

Dr Govindaraju, Chairman of the venue arrangement presented the arrangement at Palace grounds. It is in 25 acres of land. The seating capacity of the main hall will be 3000..There will be 2 or 3 entrance to the main hall.

IOA executive wanted free access between Main halls and other halls with single security process.. The area is cordoned off with elaborate security arrangements .

It was stressed that elaborate strict security arrangements have to be made in lieu of recent bombings with temporary barricades and adequate security personnel.

Arrangements for IOA executive committee, General Body meeting, IOA office, IOA Lounge, VIP Lounge with President"s lounge should be made.

Dr Rajeev Naik reported that till date they were expecting more than 2500 delegates with 21 foreign speakers and many Indian faculty.

Dr SC Goel suggested to have internet café.

Dr Chandrasekar, Treasurer reported that 94 stalls have been booked for Rs 63,10,440. He said that he is not aware of all the facts of the financial status of the conference. Most of the financial transactions have been done with the signatures of the Chairman and organizing secretary. Dr Goel suggested that the financial transactions should be transparent and there should be better interaction between chairman, org.secretary and treasurer. The statement of sponsorship accounts of IOA and conference accounts should be kept separately and must be given next day.

Trade Exhibitions: Dr Ram Subba Reddy presented the report. 42 companies have taken 94 stalls and 4 companies have fully paid. It was suggested that small halls may be created for smaller companies with sponsorship of less than 1.25 lakhs. More hospitality areas have to be created so that sponsorship revenue will go up.

Registrations: Dr Ram Iyer presented the report and his motto was understate and achieve more. There will be 15 to 20 counters for registered delegates according to the alphabetical order. There will be a separate counter for VIPs. ID cards will be colour coded . Delegate should spend less time for their registration. Members above 65 years of age will have free registration for the conference but for CME they should pay.

Membership list to be handed over to the registration committee by Mr Ramesh Panday. There should be a Bank counter and credit cards should be accepted. It was suggested that Bank should accept the IOA membership fees also because many delegates do become members during this time.

Inaguration: Hon. Secretary of IOA will be in charge and he should be consulted .Dr Sharon Patil is the local co ordinator.

Hospitality: Dr Parthasarathy presented the report. He was requested that proper directions should be given to all delegates arriving at airport and railway stations. A copy of the list of the faculty members invited, VIPs should be kept at both places.

PG teaching program should be clinically oriented with minimal lectures. There should be radiology sessions.

There should be faculty dinner on 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> of December 2008.

- c. Three members of the Editorial Board who have served continuously for three years shall retire and three members be elected from amongst the members eligible to vote in the Annual General Meeting.

- a. The main official publication of the Association shall be the Indian Journal of Orthopaedics.
- b. The positions in editorial board should be.
  - One editor (one)
  - Associate editor (two)
  - Assistant editor (three)\
  - Subject specific member editorial board ( spine, trauma, arthroplasty, arthroscopy , hand , basic sciences, statistics , pediatric , infection).
  - These all positions will have a terms of 3 years.
- c. One assistant editor and 3 member editorial board shall be filled every year.

#### Existing Clause

- 15 a Editor of the Indian Journal of Orthopaedics, Associate editors, members the editorial board shall be elected every fourth year in a manner stipulated in Rule 14(a). Editor , Associate editor and assistant editor of the Indian Journal of Orthopaedics and members editorial board shall hold office for a term of three years.

#### The clause will be replaced by-

- a. All appointment shall be done by executive committee on the recommendation of the search committee consisting of the President IOA, President elect of IOA, Hon'y. Secretary IOA, Editor IJO and immediate past editor. For the appointment of Editor 2 Past presidents should also be included in the committee.
- b. The nominated posts will be advertised in the IOA newsletter and desirous candidate should apply with their CV. The CV's will be shortlisted by the Editor and should be placed before the search committee for recommending the names. The appointment shall be done by The Executive committee.

#### Why do we need these changes – –

1. Editorial job need a group of people who work tirelessly with editorial temper hence the people with proven editorial credentials are helpful in bringing good scientific publication.
2. For the journal to compete globally we need a continuity hence the group of people need to be groomed to develop proficiency in the prescribed job.
3. If we look at the history of all reputed journals world over the editors have worked for long as member of editorial board in various capacity.
4. Since this is a performance oriented position hence it should have specified minimum eligibility (specility requirement, experience in scientific writing and interest in editorial process) to be considered for the position.

## PROPOSAL FOR THE AMENDMENT OF CONSTITUTION FOR THE FORMATION OF A WEB SITE COMMITTEE FOR THE IOA WEBSITE WWW.IOAINDIA.ORG

IOA has formed its website [www.ioaindia.org](http://www.ioaindia.org) in the year 2003 and since then it has become an ONLINE part of all our members. Its success has been the result of all its members, which can be seen by the growth of the registered and returning users. For the same you can view our previously presented reports. In a nutshell the growth of over 300% per year in terms of users interactivity and hits have been seen.

IOA INDIA web site is a portfolio and the information exchange point for not only the members but also to the visitors to study various aspects.

We constantly add the system with latest features with the ideas and the suggestion of our members. An online forum was established for the exchange of the ideas between several of our Members.

### **Benefits of having a committee**

Out of the 8 members 4 can be elected and other 4 to be nominated. The members who are nominated can be nominated by the Executive Body of the IOA. 2 web-editors would be selected out of these 8 members.

#### **Mission Statement:**

Recognizing that the website is the one constant presence in the marketplace that represents Indian Orthopaedic Association, it is critical that the website represents and supports the association's overall goals and objectives.

In line with IOA's objective to develop and maintain programs, benefits and services that enhance IOA membership, the website is considered a key technological tool to help achieve this objective. Specific objectives of the website committee are to:

- Provide current and useful online member-driven information designed to enhance the value of IOA membership.
- Provide dynamic, specialized, and relevant information to our members.
- Increase non-dues revenue for the association through advertising and vendor services on our website.
- Promote the growth of the association through by developing a "best in class" resource website, for both members and non-members.
- Make provision for the editing committee to edit all documents prior to publication on the IOA Website for the Journals.
- Make provision for each member of IOA to submit a document to be published to the editing committee.

#### **Few Recommendations:**

- We should have the IOACON Website an integral part of the IOA Website, there is no need of creating a parallel website of IOACON every year. This will also help us to create an archive of the previous IOACON's held.

**The Treasurer and** the Joint Secretary shall be nominated by the Executive from such members of the IOA who are resident and working in the Union Territory of Delhi to facilitate smooth day-to-day running of the registered office at Delhi. **One Joint Secretary will be nominated by Hon.Secretary from his city where he is residing.**

### 20. clause 15(b) - original

(b) **At least** 12 weeks before the Annual General Body Meeting, the President Elect shall send to each life member and full member eligible to vote, a notice of the election accompanied by a list of vacancies to be filled in for nomination. All nominations must be received by the President Elect within 28 days of the despatch of the notice convening the election. If there is more than one nomination for any vacancy, **election** shall be on the basis of a majority vote. Any candidate may withdraw his name at least two weeks before posting of ballot papers. The manner of election shall be secret ballot only

## **DNB, CME (ORTHOPAEDICS) 25<sup>TH</sup> -27<sup>TH</sup> JULY, 2008 AT LADY HARDINGE MED. COLLEGE, NEW DELHI.**

### **DETAILED REPORT**

The programme started at 8.00 a.m. on 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2008. The venue was the 1<sup>st</sup> Floor Hall in the Swarn Jayanti Auditorium of Lady Hardinge Medical College. It is an air condition hall which can easily seat 50-60 people. A total of 26 candidates, whose list was sent by DNB, reported for the course. Few local post graduates also joined later, whenever the faculty members from other institutions came to participate. The candidates were allotted the cases at 8.00 a.m.

The inaugural function started at 9.30 a.m. Dr. G.K. Sharma, Director, L.H.M.C was the chief guest, Dr. A.K. Sood, Executive Director, National Board of Examination was the guest of honour. Dr. Anil Mehtani, Head of the Department of Orthopaedics, L.H.M.C. and Dr. Sudhir K.Kapoor were the other dignitaries on the dias. The inaugural programme started with the lamp lighting and silent prayers to Goddess Saraswati. Dr. Anil Mehtani welcomed the guests and the delegates. Dr. G.K. Sharma and Dr. A.K. Sood spoke about their views about the course. Dr. Sudhir K. Kapoor delivered the vote of thanks. The inaugural function finished at 10.00 a.m. and it was followed by tea.

The first day was devoted to long cases. Patients had already been given an appointment to reach the venue. The list of long cases, who had come for the CME, is as follows:

1. 9 years old child with caries spine L2-3 with psoas abcess, right hip with flexion deformity.
2. 50 years old male with disc prolapsed at L4-5 level.
3. 45 years old male with ankylosing spondylitis affecting spine and both hips.
4. 19 years old male with ununited subtrochantric fracture femur.
5. 15 years old female with T.B. hip left side with adduction deformity.
6. 46 years old male with bilateral AVN hips.
7. 30 years old male with bilateral AVN hips, with one sided THR done.
8. 45 years old male with one sided AVN hip with shortening.
9. 55 years old male with old ununited fracture neck femur.

These cases were discussed in two sessions.

(1) In pre noon session, the faculty members were Dr. Shishir Rastogi, Dr. Ravi Mittal, Dr. Anil Mehtani and Dr. Sudhir K. Kapoor. (2) In Post lunch session, the faculty members were Dr. V.K. Gautam, Dr. A.K. Gupta, Dr. Lalit Maini and Dr. Sudhir K. Kapoor. Tea was taken at 3.00 p.m. and the first day concluded at 5.00 p.m.

**Second day's programme on 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2008.** The programme started at 8.00 a.m. There were 12 short cases. The patients had been given prior appointment to reach the venue. All of them reported for discussions. The list of the cases as follows:

2. 7 years old male with old monteggia fracture dislocation.
3. 30 years old male with 13 months old neglected tri malleolar fracture.
4. 16 years old male with T.B. Knee.
5. 45 years old male with malignant tumour hand.
6. 25 years male with chronic osteomyelitis tibia with discharging sinus.

7. 7 years old female with T.B. elbow with stiffness.
8. 13 years old male with VIC right hand.
9. 19 years old male with VIC left hand.
10. 4 years old male with neglected CTEV bilateral.
11. 8 years old male with bilateral synostosis radius and ulna.
12. 8 years old male with bilateral genu valgum

The faculty members in the pre noon session were, Dr. A.K. Jain, Dr. Deepak Mittal, Dr. Arya, Dr. Hitesh Lal along with Dr. Sudhir K. Kapoor. Six cases were discussed in the morning. The tea break was at 11.00 a.m. and lunch at 1.30 P.M.

In the evening session, faculty members included Dr. Mukesh Kalra, Dr. Sumit Sural, Dr. Vinod Kumar, Dr. Mathew Varghese and Dr. Sudhir K. Kapoor. The tea break was at 3.00 p.m and the programme finished at 5.00 p.m.

**Final day's programme on 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2008:** Final day's programme started at 8.00 a.m. Practical and table viva was planned for the day. The faculty members included Dr. Anil Jain, Dr. Mathew Varghese, Dr. V.K. Sharma, Dr. C.S. Yadav and Dr. S.K. Kapoor. Five sessions were conducted as follows:

1. X-rays - one and half an hour
2. How to appear in theory paper. 45 minutes
3. Orthotic and Prosthetics - one and half an hour
4. Ward Round - one hour.
5. Instruments and implants - one hour

The programme concluded at 3.30 p.m. In a short Valedictory function, the candidates were given certificates by Dr. V.K. Sharma, Director, C.I.O., New Delhi.
