## An Appeal

Dear Learned Members,

The Indian Journal of Orthopaedics is a peer reviewed and open access journal published on Bimonthly basis. At present approximately 11000 hard copies of each issue are circulated to learned members free of cost every year. This number will further keep on increasing every year with new addition of members. IJO wants to contribute to nature and environment conservation. We can help nature individually by opting for soft copies only. This will conserve trees and save money as well. Most of the countries in the world are moving towards paperless work with an aim to save the trees and keep the environment green and pollution free. 1 tree contributes 8,333.3 A4 size sheets.

We are printing 11000 copies of each issue and let us take one issue of 100 pages i.e.  $11000 \times 100 = 11,00,000$  sheets and for six issues we require  $11,00,000 \times 6 = 66,00,000$  sheets. For printing of 66 Lac sheets per year, we consume approx. 800 trees. Now you can imagine that how much damage we are doing to our environment by cutting so many trees every year. Let us all contribute something to save our environment by going paperless and choosing soft copy (online version) of IJO instead of hard copy and also promise to plant more trees nearby to your home/office/park/road side etc. to keep the country green and save our environment.

The printing and distribution cost of IJO is increasing day by day. With implementation of GST, one issue of IJO costs (printing plus postage) approximately 14-16 Lac which is too expensive.
